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Robert Foley to Speak at Bringing World's Together in Farmington

Farmington- **Former U.S. Navy SEAL Robert Foley** will be the keynote speaker at the upcoming **Bringing Worlds Together Conference for Veterans, Family Members, and Community that will take place on Saturday, September 17th**. The conference is offered by Tri-County Mental Health Services. Foley is an inspirational speaker who speaks nationally for U.S. Veteran groups and others. His presentations address sensitive issues on Post Traumatic Stress (PTS), Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI), Military Sexual Trauma (MST,) and Veteran Suicide. On September 17th Foley will convey powerful strategies to curb veteran suicide and share opportunities for collaboration between mental health professionals and one of their most valuable unrecognized resource tools... Veterans.

After his keynote speech Foley will be joined in the morning and afternoon conference sessions by Portland-based psychiatrist. Ben Grasso, MD to discuss "B.A.M." Body Alarm Management, which is a unique, model of understanding how to live with the ancient biology in all our brains. Dr. Grasso and Robert Foley will offer a roadmap for coping with PTS as a natural, predictable consequence of exposure to the horrors of war.
